

Seniors Activities

Sierra County administers a wide variety of support services designed to aid and employ seniors. All services are provided free of charge or by donation. Call 575.894.6641

Retired and Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP) Coordinates placing volunteers throughout the county.

The Foster Grandparent Program Seniors work one-on-one with students in schools and day-care centers to give mentoring and tutoring.

Senior Companion Program Volunteers visit seniors in their homes, providing companionship, entertainment and outings helping Seniors live independently in their homes.

Chore Service Assists seniors with maintaining their yards and small repairs on their homes.

Volunteer Income Tax Assistance Income tax preparation is provided to low-income seniors.

Home Delivered Meals Prepared meals are delivered to seniors living throughout the county.

Recreational Programs A large variety of activities and games are scheduled weekly.

Congregate Meals Breakfast and lunch are provided at 2 sites for seniors.

Homemaking Services Volunteers help seniors maintain their homes.

Transportation Daily van transportation service is provided around the county and semi-monthly to Las Cruces.

Respite Care Services In-home respite care is provided for full-time care-givers of seniors with Alzheimer's Disease and related dementia.

Thrift Store Seniors shop for low-cost clothing and household items.
