The Vietnam Memorial Wall, the focal point of the Veterans Memorial Park, was dedicated November 8, 2003. After touring the U.S. and

Ireland, the half-size replica of the original Vietnam Memorial Wall in Washington D.C. has found a home in Truth or Consequences.

Dedication of the Wall is part of a 5-year plan to complete the Park.

The Wall is inscribed with 58,220 names of men and women who gave their lives for America. The Visitors Center's friendly staff will supply information on any of the people whose names are on the wall.



Behind the Vietnam Wall is the Walk of History. It is designed in the shape of a five-pointed star, with each point having a commemorative plaque for one of the wars in which our country has fought. The Walk starts with the Revolutionary War and continues through the Iraq War. A columbarium designed to hold the ashes of 72 individuals is found at the rear of the park. A covered seating area is provided for services and contemplation. A museum is planned.
